Artist Submission Rules and Guidelines

- The bra design shall be in good taste in the sole discretion of Zonta. Any submission(s) not meeting these criteria will be disqualified. If the design includes any mechanical devices such as battery packs, this must be accessible to event staff. Some submissions may be modeled by local firefighters or police officers. Therefore, we suggest a minimum size of 38C be used and that the back and adjustable straps not be stitched or glued.
- Entries must be accompanied by your name, address, contact information and title of the piece on a small sheet of paper attached to the entry for ease of identification.
- All entries are due no later than Monday, September 25, 2017 by 4:00 p.m. Submission may be delivered in person to 1007 North Buffalo, Cleburne, Texas 76033, or sent by mail or by courier service (FedEx, UPS, etc.) to the same address. If you need to have a bra picked up, please call Carolyn Smith at 817-556-8255.
- Works will be considered in-kind, charitable donations and therefore the property of Zonta. Zonta is a 501(c)(3), and all contributions to it are tax deductible to the full extent of the law. Zonta accepts no responsibility for submissions that are lost, delayed, damaged, altered, mislaid, howsoever caused.
- The Art Bra Event & Auction is the signature fundraiser for Zonta Club of Johnson County Foundation (Zonta), a non-profit organization providing advocacy and services to empower women locally and worldwide. A portion of the proceeds from this fundraiser will benefit local charities as well as women throughout Johnson County who have been diagnosed with breast cancer. The event and all functions related to it are intended as a benefit.
- In order to participate in Art Bra Event, you must agree to these Rules and Guidelines, which consist of (i) the terms and conditions on these pages; and (ii) the Entry Form. If you are a minor, you must obtain the prior permission of your parent and/or legal guardian, who must agree to these Rules and Guidelines on his/her and your behalf. Submission of an entry in this fundraiser constitutes your agreement to these Rules and Guidelines.
- Entries may also be other forms of art rather than an art bra. The entry shall be in good taste in the sole discretion of Zonta. If the design includes any mechanical devices such as battery packs, this must be accessible to event staff.
- By participating in the fundraiser, you agree and hereby grant Zonta permission to use, copy, modify, distribute, publicly display, sell, and/or auction your submission for any purpose, such as, but not limited to, press and media communications, without any compensation to you. You also agree that Zonta may use your name and likeness to administer and promote the fundraiser and any additional promotional events related to the fundraiser. Zonta will hold the rights to any photographs made of the submissions and may use them to create merchandise for sale at a future date. Entrants will not be compensated for the inclusion of their entries in such merchandise.
- The fundraiser is governed by the laws of the State of Texas. By participating, you agree to be bound by the terms of these Rules and Guidelines and by Zonta's decisions, which are final and binding on all matters pertaining to this fundraiser. Each entrant agrees not to act in any manner that might: (i) infringe any third-party proprietary, intellectual property, industrial property, personal rights or other rights, including without limitation, copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret or confidentiality obligation. To the extent permitted by the law, the right to litigate, to seek injunctive relief, or to any other recourse to judicial or any other procedure in case of disputes or claims resulting from or in connection to this fundraiser are hereby excluded, and you expressly waive any and all such rights.
