Dear Community Partner,

Since the COVID-19 pandemic began, there has been a sharp rise in the number of women killed by their partners in North Texas. Calls to local domestic violence relief organizations have skyrocketed. Now, more than ever, the women of our community need us.

Since 1981, the Zonta Club of Johnson County has played an active role in Cleburne, Burleson, and the surrounding areas by advocating for the empowerment of women and girls. By partnering with organizations like the Family Crisis Center of Johnson County and the Texas Health Resources Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Program, we Zontians advocate for the end of violence against women, while also attending to the direct needs of victims. We also volunteer with Legal Aid of Northwest Texas to provide legal assistance to low-income individuals within Johnson County, many of whom have survived violence in their own homes.

Other projects involve supporting Camp Fire and the American Legion Auxiliary of Texas by providing funds to send girls to summer camp where they are empowered to grow in their confidence as leaders. We also support the Christian Women's Job Corp whose curriculum prepares disadvantaged women to be valuable members of the workforce. Annually, we provide scholarships to high school seniors and to women returning to college later in life.

In an effort to continue to meet the needs of women, The Zonta Club of Johnson County will be hosting its fourth annual **Winter Frolic Casino Event** on Saturday, February 26, 2022, at the Cleburne Conference Center. All proceeds of this event will support the club's service and advocacy projects.
